1. Introduction

Ragani Chandeshwori Campus took the initiative to organize an inter-school quiz competition with the aim of encouraging academic excellence and building intellectual confidence among students at the basic education level. The program was designed to strengthen student knowledge across key school subjects and promote constructive competition in a supportive environment. The event saw active participation from six local schools, each sending a team of three students. The quiz competition was not only a knowledge-sharing platform but also an opportunity to foster community engagement in education.

2. Objectives

The core objectives of this quiz program were as follows:

- ❖ To promote academic interest and excellence among basic level students.
- ❖ To strengthen students' grasp on core school subjects including Nepali, English, and Science.
- ❖ To develop public speaking, critical thinking, and teamwork among young learners.
- ❖ To enhance cooperation between Ragani Chandeshwori Campus and nearby basic level schools.
- ❖ To create a lively, participatory learning environment that values both education and friendly competition.

3. Expected Outcomes

- ❖ The event was designed with the following outcomes in mind:
- ❖ Students would gain more confidence in their subject knowledge.
- ❖ Learning would be reinforced in a fun and interactive manner.
- ❖ Participants would learn the importance of collaboration and healthy competition.
- ❖ Local schools would become more engaged in collaborative academic activities.
- ❖ The overall academic environment of the community would be enriched.

4. Event Schedule

Time: 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Venue: Ragani Chandeshwori Campus.

Participants: Six schools, each represented by three students

Participating Schools:

1. Shree Buddha Basic School
2. Shree Chandeshwori Secondary School, Ragani
3. Shree Chuli Basic School

4. Shree Narmadeshwor Secondary School
5. Shree Phulmati Secondary School
6. Shree Chandeshwori Secondary School, Majhgaun

The event was formally inaugurated with welcome remarks by the campus coordinator and a brief overview of the program. Guests included teachers, students, and community representatives.

5. Methodology

The quiz competition was structured in five rounds, each aligned with a school subject or area of general awareness:

First Round – Nepali Subject Questions:

This round focused on grammar, literature, and language-based questions from the Nepali curriculum. Each team was asked direct questions that reflected their classroom learning.

Second Round – English Subject Questions:

The second round involved comprehension-based and grammar-related questions in English. This tested the students' understanding of English as a second language and their classroom performance.

Third Round – Science Subject Questions:

In this round, participants were asked basic level science questions covering general scientific facts, natural phenomena, and conceptual understanding relevant to their grade level.

Fourth Round – Mathematics:

This final round challenged students with mental math, arithmetic, basic geometry, word problems, and logical reasoning. It was designed to assess students' problem-solving and analytical thinking under time pressure.

Fifth Round – General Knowledge (GK):

This round included questions about current affairs, national symbols, geography, history, and famous personalities. This section was designed to broaden students' knowledge beyond textbooks.

Each round was evaluated by a panel of judges from the faculty members of Ragani Chandeshwori Campus. Teams were awarded points based on accuracy, confidence, and time management.

6. Conclusion

The inter-school quiz competition was a successful and impactful educational event. All participating schools showed high levels of enthusiasm and preparation. Students confidently answered subject-specific questions, demonstrating both depth and breadth of knowledge. The

event met its goal of creating a lively, academic environment that was both educational and enjoyable. Ragani Chandeshwori Campus received appreciation from school representatives, and the event served as a model for future academic programs.

7. Recommendations

Based on the successful execution of this quiz program, the following recommendations are proposed:

- ❖ The quiz competition should be held on a regular basis, ideally annually.
- ❖ More schools from the surrounding areas should be invited to participate.
- ❖ Quiz training sessions or preparatory workshops could be introduced to support students beforehand.
- ❖ It is recommended to continue subject-wise round format as it aligns with school curriculum and enhances learning outcomes.
